

Curved Cross Hatch Sample Quilt

Curved Cross Hatch Sample Quilt Approximate finished size 53 x 53 inches Yardage Amounts & Cutting Instructions

Note: Amounts are generous
wof = width of fabric, selvedge to selvedge
Yardages are based on 40 inch wide fabric

Light Fabric

Blocks & Outer Border **2-3/4 yards**

Dark Fabric

Sashing & Binding **1 yard**

Batting of Choice **1-3/4 yard** - 90 inches wide

Items you will need for the quilting -

Thread - Use whatever thread works in your quilting machine. When quilting this type of sampler style quilt, I like to use contrasting thread so that my quilting will show! The quilting of this quilt is the focal point!

Templates & Stencil Grids - This quilt uses the **Longarm University Curved Cross Hatch template**. For information about this template go to

The **Curved Cross Hatch** template works with a grid system that is drawn onto your fabric. To have the most accurate grids, the **Longarm University 1 inch Stencil Grid** is highly recommended. For information about this Stencil Grid go to

Other items you will need -

If you are using the Feather Guide templates, you will need a base unit or table for your quilting machine. **DO NOT QUILT TEMPLATES WITHOUT A BASE UNIT!!**

Temporary Quilt Basting Spray - I prefer the June Taylor brand, but any brand will work.

Marking pens of choice. I prefer the Fine Point Crayola Washable Markers. Note - to remove the marker, the quilt **MUST** be washed in warm water, with detergent, in a washing machine.

Straight edge rotary cutting rulers for marking registration lines.

Safety pins for pin basting.
