
**Directional Piecing Patterns**—The Feathered Baptist Fan pattern IS directional and this should be considered before starting to quilt. This is important especially when quilting over a piecing pattern that is also directional. The illustrations below shows the Feathered Baptist Fan quilted on a School House quilt.

The first illustration shows how the Feathered Baptist Fan would look if the quilt is applied to the quilting machine in the usual manner with the top raw edge of the quilt attached to the take up roller.



The illustration below shows how the Feathered Baptist Fan would look if the quilt is applied to the quilting machine with the **bottom** raw edge of the quilt attached to the take up roller.

Either of these is "correct". You have to determine which is the best for the quilt you are working on.
